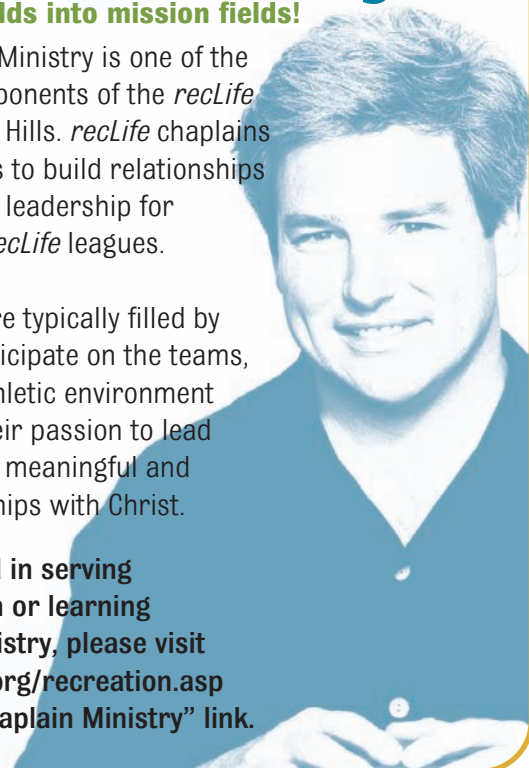
reLife Chaplain Ministry

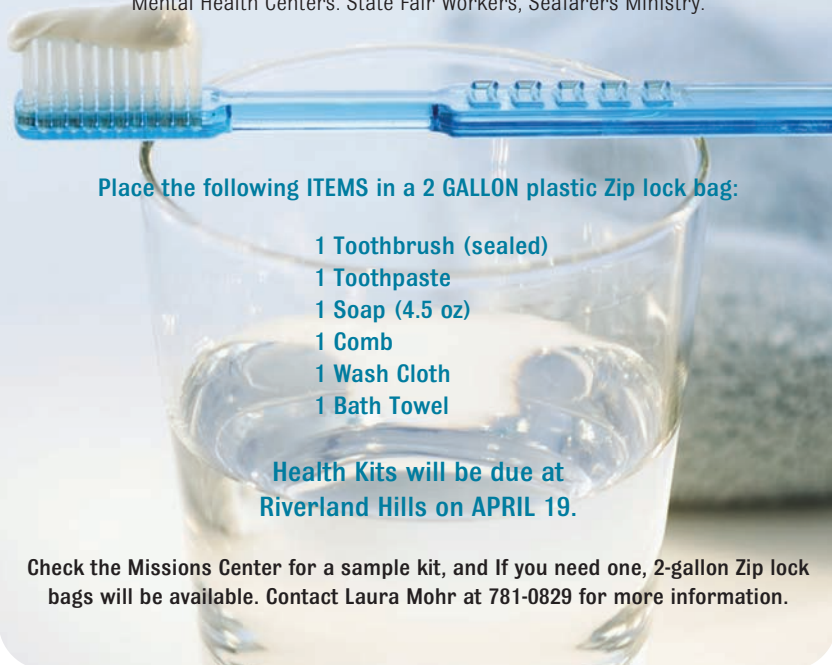
