Our health has come from the continuous infusion of new life. “Most of the members of Riverland Hills, were not native to Dutch Fork area, but came from neighboring communities.” New people have kept us from stagnation. New ideas, new energy and new passion have challenged us to grow spiritually and in numbers.

Here we are at our 40th Anniversary month and for us it is “just one mile marker among many” as we breeze on down the road. It has been a wonderful trip thus far, but we’ve only begun to see what God will do.

SOME FUN FACTS:

- The Sportsman’s Restaurant, Columbia, was the place the dream took shape during a committee meeting of the South Carolina Baptist Convention. (1964)
- Lexington Baptist Church voted to be the RHBC sponsoring church.
- A lifelong member of the Lutheran Church, Miss Mary Lou Corley, sold land on St. Andrews Road for a church. She joked, “I wanted a Lutheran Church there; but if it can’t be Lutheran, then I would rather it be a Baptist Church.”
- Irmo High School was the site of the first RHBC services.
- On March 3, 1968 the RHBC mission was constituted as a Church.

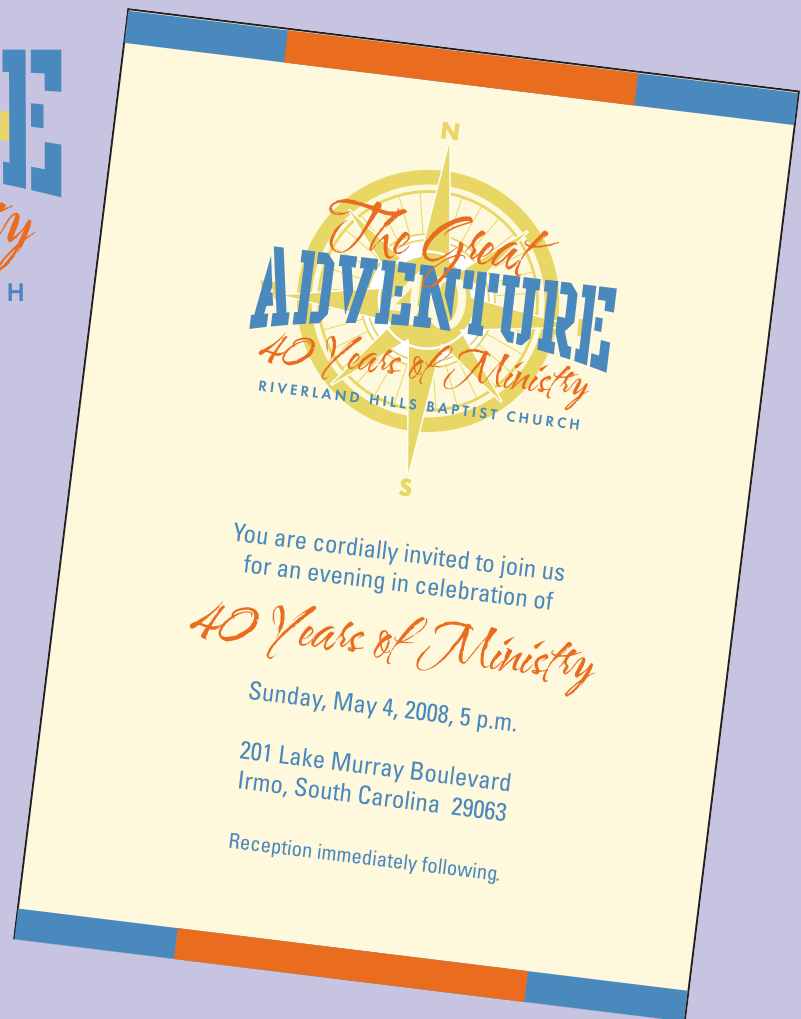
