- 6) Be consistent.
- 7) Never publicly humiliate a child.
- 8) Only tell them once.

**You won't need a robe, a music degree, or a rehearsal—just a desire to give God glory!**

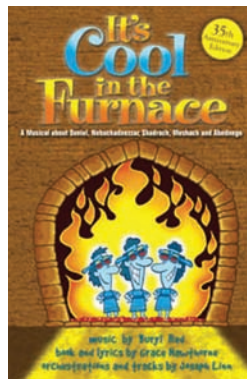
## Music Camp 2009 Grades 1 - 6

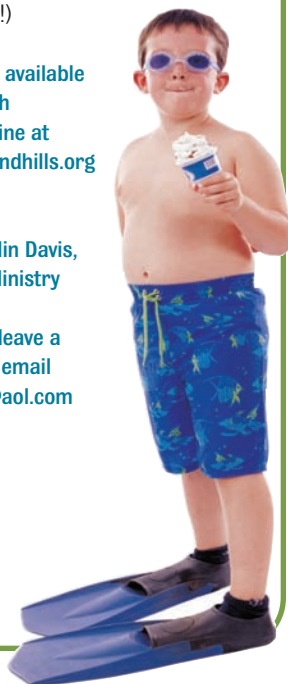
