## Giving Thanks to God

### CORRIE TEN BOOM IN THE HIDING PLACE

relates an incident that taught her always to be thankful. She and her sister, Betsy, had just been transferred to the worst German prison camp they had seen yet, Ravensbruck. On entering the barracks, they found them extremely overcrowded and flea-infested. That morning, their Scripture reading in 1 Thessalonians had reminded them to rejoice always, pray constantly, and give thanks in all circumstances.

Betsy told Corrie to stop and thank the Lord for every detail of their new living quarters. Corrie at first flatly refused to give thanks for the fleas, but Betsy persisted, and Corrie finally succumbed to her pleadings.

During the months spent at the camp, they were surprised to find how openly they could hold Bible study and prayer meetings without guard interference. It was not until several months later that they learned the reason the guards would not enter the barracks was because of the fleas.

AND, in Enterprise, Alabama there is a monument to an insect: the Mexican Boll Weevil. In 1895 weevils destroyed the major crop of the county, cotton. In desperation farmers diversified and by 1919 the new peanut crop was many times what cotton had been at its height. In that year of prosperity a monument was built. The inscription reads: "In profound appreciation of the boll weevil and what it has done as the herald of prosperity this monument was erected by the citizens of Enterprise, Coffee County, Alabama."

Scriptures tell us to give thanks to God in all circumstances.

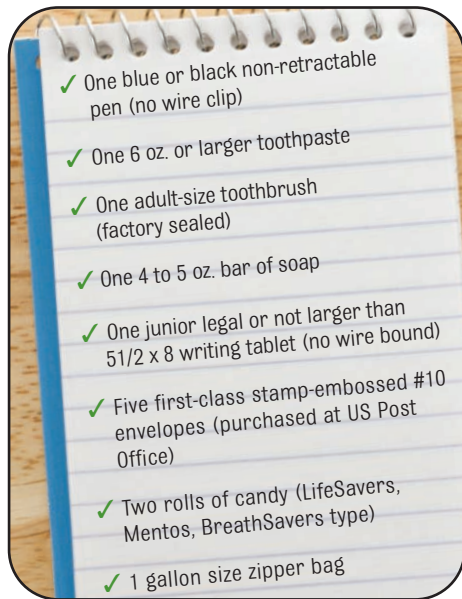
